or the second straight month, The Walt Disney Co. topped the BetterInvesting community's Most Active List, with 207 buys and 57 sells. Significantly, the proportion of buys over sells among Disney investors was down from March and April, when growth prospects for the company in relation to its share price may have seemed more promising. Then came COVID-19, with closing of theme parks, fewer sporting events drawing viewers to Disney's ESPN network and the delay of much-awaited Disney films like "Mulan."


