

- Questions from visitors:
 - Since it has been awhile... how does title insurance work? Is it a one-time purchase, or an annual fee??
 - Title insurance is a one-time fee at the time of purchase of a piece of real property.
 - o Essent then would be the better bet because it is POTENTIALLY a longer period.
 - Not necessarily, the risk in a title insurance company is that do a good research on the front end. It is rare that they payout anything. As they discussed, mortgage insurance companies are at risk for the life of the mortgage (that risk reduces over time as the mortgage balance decreases but longer-time adds risk of job loss of the mortgage payor).
- General Comment: Today's meeting had two excellent presentations and discussions: Ira's
 education presentation had a lot of new information to me. Joe and Stephen's discussion on
 PMI vs Title Insurance was very informative. Stephen's analysis was very thorough.
