

Stock Study Presentation – Brent presented the SSG analysis for Universal Display (OLED) and recommended purchase of this stock. Club members discussed and presented their input on the discussion.

Review of Stock Portfolio: Members presented their updates for stocks they were watching. Sriram presented the Bivio Valuation Report during the individual presentations. After individual presentations, club members discussed status of all the holdings.

Watchlist update: Two BUY recommendations from the updated watch list discussions: IBP (2/12/2022) and MPWR (9/10/2022). ASML (7/9/2022) and INMD (11/12/2022) are both HOLDs.

Buy/Sell decisions – After discussion the club decided the following:

Add OLED to the watch list. Looking for \$112 price target to buy.

SELL: None.

BUY: Buy INMD and CLFD (50/50) with available cash.

 - The Small Cap Informer is an ICLUBcentral product written by Doug Gerlach with Russell Malley as the analyst. In the most current issue, OLED carries a buy up to price of 146, a sell-above target of 279, a projected total return of 21.8% and a risk/reward ratio of 4.1:1. The full discussion of OLED was in the December 2021 issue. Joe F
- FYI: 2021 10-K shows long-term lease liabilities of \$27.263M ... that's why the debt/capital on SSG shows 2.4% ... note: leases are GAAP accounting requirement on Balance Sheet as of recent years and on a go forward basis.

- The Pre-Tax Profit Margin also appears a bit cyclical coordinating with tv, phone sales around Christmas
 - I agree Brian. OLED as a sub-product provides does not exclusively control its fate.
