Iwas recently part of a club operations webinar with Doug Gerlach, president of ICLUB central, during which he discussed the addition of the Super Sectors category to the Sector & Industry Diversification report in myICLUB.com. This small change has the potential to make portfolio management easier and more productive. Here's why I'm excited about this change.


he Super Sector category groups economic sectors by their sensitivity to the economic cycle. Sectors within a Super Sector have a high correlation to one another but less correlation to sectors in other Super Sectors. A well-diversified portfolio would have companies that perform well in different phases of the economic cycle.

The Super Sector concept makes it easier to allocate resources among companies with different performance characteristics relative to the economic cycle.

Investing in all Super Sectors helps spread the risk throughout the economic cycle. In the webinar it was suggested a portfolio should have at least 15 percent invested in each Super Sector. Here are the Super Sector categories: **Defensive Super Sector**:

- Health care Consumer defensive Utilities Sensitive Super Sector:
- Communication services
- Industrials
- Cyclical Super Sector:
- Basic materials
- Financial services
- Energy
 - Technology
 - Consumer cyclical
 - Real estate

When I saw this concept, I immediately generated the report for a portfolio I help manage.


