

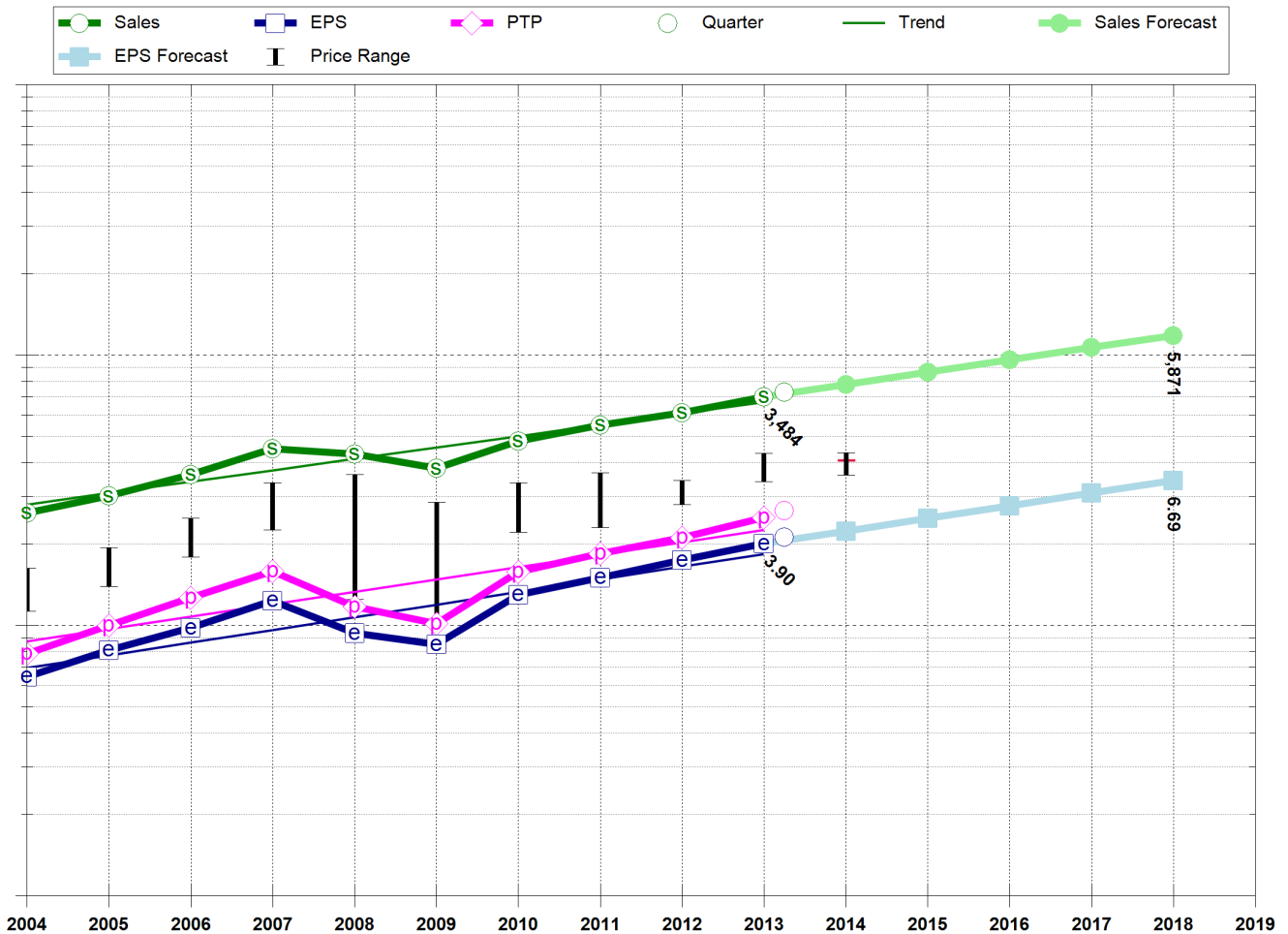

4 EVALUATING RISK and REWARD over the next 5 years

Assuming one recession and one business boom every 5 years, calculations are made of how high and how low the stock might sell. The upside-downside ratio is the key to evaluating risk and reward.

A HIGH PRICE - NEXT 5 YEARS

Avg. High P/E 24.00 X Estimate High Earnings/Share 6.69 = Forecasted High Price \$ 160.6

B LOW PRICE - NEXT 5 YEARS

(a) Avg. Low P/E 15.50 X Estimate Low Earnings/Share 3.90 = Forecasted Low Price \$ 60.5

(b) Avg. Low Price of Last 5 Years 45.7

(c) Recent Market Low Price 54.47

(d) Price Dividend Will Support $\frac{\text{Present Dividend}}{\text{High Yield}} = \frac{1.760}{2.30\%} = 76.5$

Selected Forecasted Low Price \$ 60.5

C ZONING using 25%-50%-25%

D UPSIDE DOWNSIDE RATIO (POTENTIAL GAIN VS. RISK OR LOSS)

$\frac{\text{High Price} - \text{Present Price}}{\text{Present Price}} = \frac{160.6 - 79.03}{79.03} = 1.03$
 $\frac{\text{Present Price} - \text{Low Price}}{\text{Present Price} - \text{Low Price}} = \frac{79.03 - 60.5}{79.03 - 60.5} = 1.00$
 Ratio = 1.03 / 1.00 = 1.03 To 1

E PRICE TARGET (Note: This shows the potential market price appreciation over the next five years in simple interest terms.)

$\frac{\text{High Price} - \text{Present Market Price}}{\text{Present Market Price}} = \frac{160.6 - 79.03}{79.03} = 1.03$
 $1.03 \times 100 = 103.16 - 100 = 3.16\%$ % Appreciation

5 5-YEAR POTENTIAL

This combines price appreciation with dividend yield to get an estimate of total return. It provides a standard for comparing income and growth stocks.

A $\frac{\text{Present Full Year's Dividend \$}}{\text{Present Price of Stock}} = \frac{1.76}{79.03} = 0.02 = 2.2\%$ Present Yield

B AVERAGE YIELD - USING FORECAST HIGH P/E

$\frac{\text{Avg. \% Payout}}{\text{Forecast High PE}} = \frac{45.0\%}{24.00} = 1.9\%$

AVERAGE YIELD - USING FORECAST AVERAGE P/E

$\frac{\text{Avg. \% Payout}}{\text{Forecast Average PE}} = \frac{45.0\%}{19.75} = 2.3\%$
