

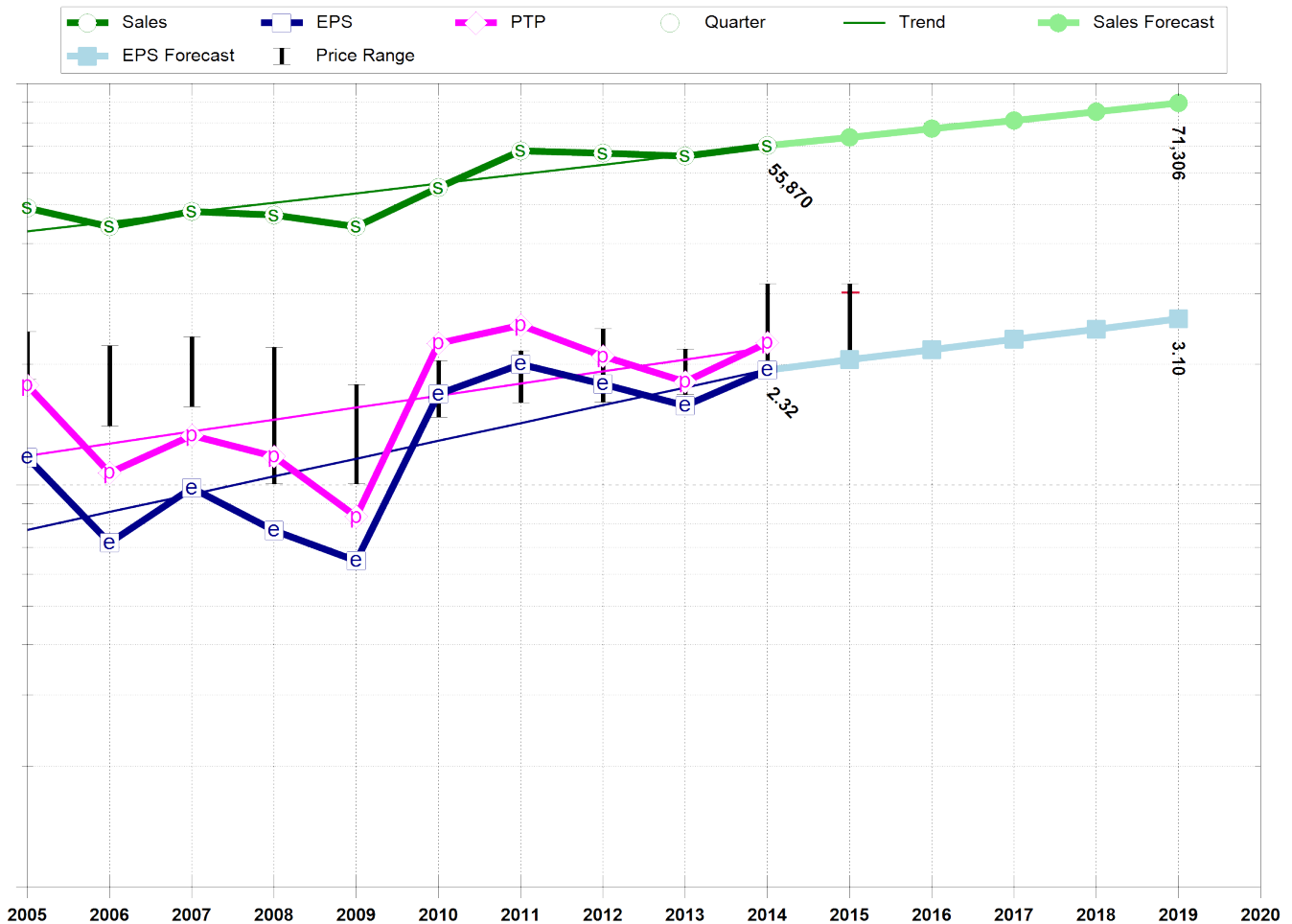

This shows how stock prices have fluctuated with earnings and dividends. It is building block for translating earnings into future stock prices.

4 EVALUATING RISK and REWARD over the next 5 years

Assuming one recession and one business boom every 5 years, calculations are made of how high and how low the stock might sell. The upside-downside ratio is the key to evaluating risk and reward.

A HIGH PRICE - NEXT 5 YEARS

Avg. High P/E 18.00 X Estimate High Earnings/Share 3.10 = Forecasted High Price \$ 55.8

B LOW PRICE - NEXT 5 YEARS

(a) Avg. Low P/E 12.00 X Estimate Low Earnings/Share 2.32 = Forecasted Low Price \$ 27.8

(b) Avg. Low Price of Last 5 Years 19.9

(c) Recent Market Low Price 20.10

(d) Price Dividend Will Support $\frac{\text{Present Dividend}}{\text{High Yield}} = \frac{0.900}{3.80\%} = 23.7$

C ZONING using 25%-50%-25%

Forecasted High Price 55.8 Minus Forecasted Low Price 27.5 = 28.3 Range. 25% of Range 7.1

Buy Zone 27.5 to 34.6

Present Market Price of 36.09 is in the **Hold** Zone

D UPSIDE DOWNSIDE RATIO (POTENTIAL GAIN VS. RISK OR LOSS)

$\frac{\text{High Price} - \text{Present Price}}{\text{Present Price} - \text{Minus Low Price}} = \frac{55.8 - 36.09}{36.09 - 27.5} = \frac{19.71}{8.59} = 2.3$ To 1

E PRICE TARGET (Note: This shows the potential market price appreciation over the next five years in simple interest terms.)

$\frac{\text{High Price}}{\text{Present Market Price}} = \frac{55.8}{36.09} = 1.55$ X 100 = 154.61 - 100 = 54.6 % Appreciation

5 5-YEAR POTENTIAL

This combines price appreciation with dividend yield to get an estimate of total return. It provides a standard for comparing income and growth stocks.

A $\frac{\text{Present Full Year's Dividend \$}}{\text{Present Price of Stock}} = \frac{0.90}{36.09} = 0.02 = 2.5\%$ Present Yield

B AVERAGE YIELD - USING FORECAST HIGH P/E

$\frac{\text{Avg. \% Payout}}{\text{Forecast High PE}} = \frac{38.3\%}{18.00} = 2.1\%$

AVERAGE YIELD - USING FORECAST AVERAGE P/E

$\frac{\text{Avg. \% Payout}}{\text{Forecast Average PE}} = \frac{38.3\%}{15.00} = 2.6\%$
