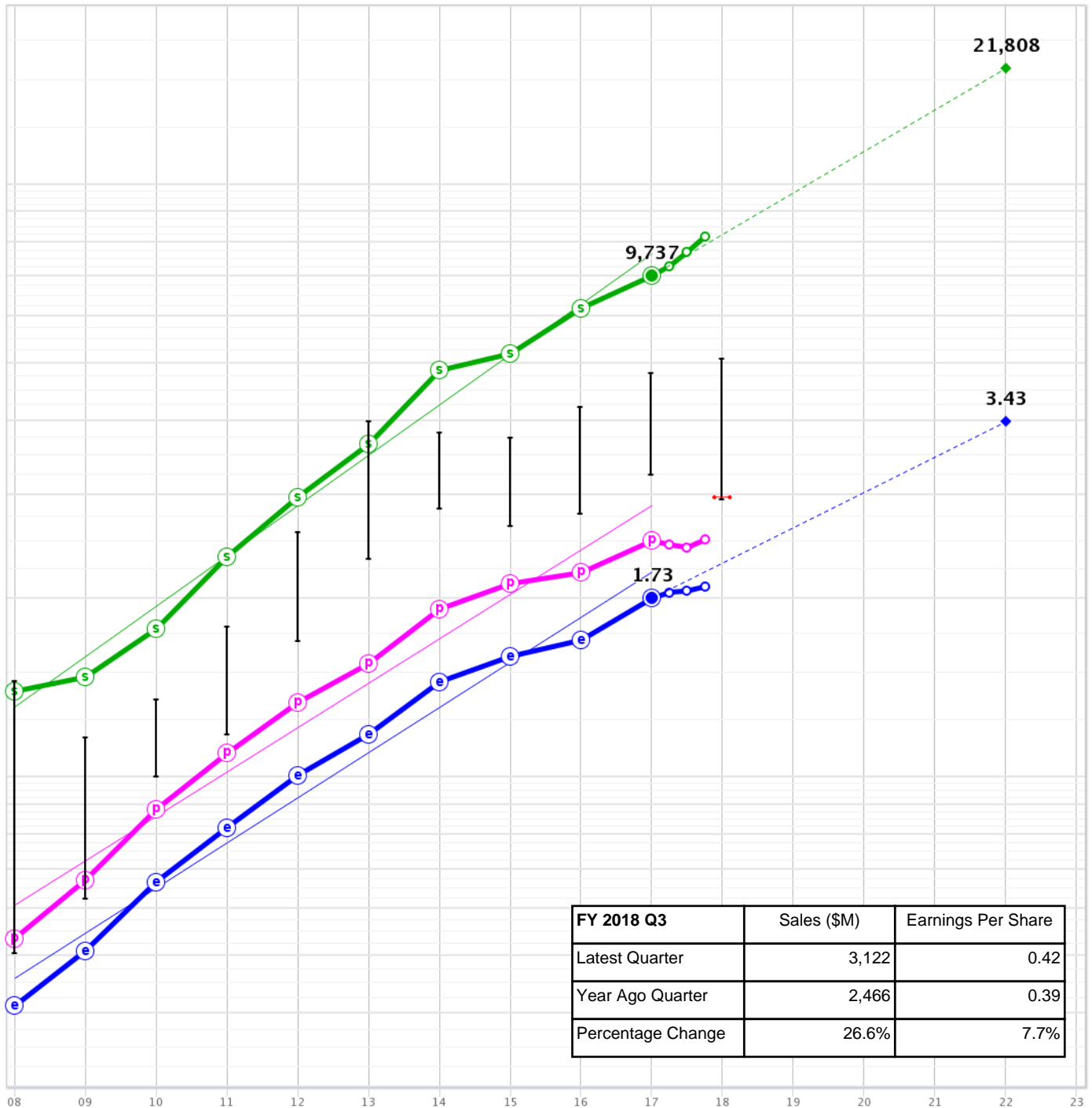

4 EVALUATING RISK and REWARD over the next 5 years

Assuming one recession and one business boom every 5 years, calculations are made of how high and how low the stock might sell. The upside-downside ratio is the key to evaluating risk and reward.

A HIGH PRICE - NEXT 5 YEARS

Avg. High P/E 24.0 X Estimate High Earnings/Share 3.43 = Forecasted High Price \$ 82.4

B LOW PRICE - NEXT 5 YEARS

(a) Avg. Low P/E 17.6 X Estimate Low Earnings/Share 1.73 = Forecasted Low Price \$ 30.4

(b) Avg. Low Price of Last 5 Years 23.9

(c) Recent Market Low Price 24.0

(d) Price Dividend Will Support $\frac{\text{Indicated Dividend}}{\text{High Yield}} = \frac{0.00}{0.00\%} = 0.0$

Selected Forecasted Low Price \$ 20.5

C ZONING using 25%-50%-25%

Forecasted High Price 82.4 Minus Forecasted Low Price 20.5 = 61.9 Range. 25% of Range 15.5

Buy Zone 20.5 to 36.0

Hold Zone 36.0 to 66.9

Sell Zone 66.9 to 82.4

Present Market Price of 25.63 is in the **BUY** Zone

D UPSIDE DOWNSIDE RATIO (POTENTIAL GAIN VS. RISK OR LOSS)

$\frac{\text{High Price} - \text{Present Price}}{\text{Present Price}} = \frac{82.4 - 25.63}{25.63} = \frac{56.80}{25.63} = 2.2161$
 $\frac{\text{Present Price} - \text{Low Price}}{\text{Low Price}} = \frac{25.63 - 20.5}{20.5} = \frac{5.13}{20.5} = 0.2502$
 Ratio = $\frac{2.2161}{0.2502} = 8.86$ To 1

E PRICE TARGET (Note: This shows the potential market price appreciation over the next five years in simple interest terms.)

$\frac{\text{High Price} - \text{Closing Price}}{\text{Closing Price}} = \frac{82.4 - 25.63}{25.63} = 3.2161$ X 100 = 321.61 - 100 = 221.6 % Appreciation

5 5-YEAR POTENTIAL

This combines price appreciation with dividend yield to get an estimate of total return. It provides a standard for comparing income and growth stocks.

A $\frac{\text{Indicated Annual Dividend}}{\text{Closing Price}} = \frac{0.00}{25.63} = 0.0000 = 0.0\%$ Current Yield

B AVERAGE YIELD - USING FORECAST HIGH P/E

$\frac{\text{Avg. \% Payout}}{\text{Forecast High PE}} = \frac{0.0\%}{24.00} = 0.0\%$

AVERAGE YIELD - USING FORECAST AVERAGE P/E

$\frac{\text{Avg. \% Payout}}{\text{Forecast Average PE}} = \frac{0.0\%}{20.80} = 0.0\%$
