

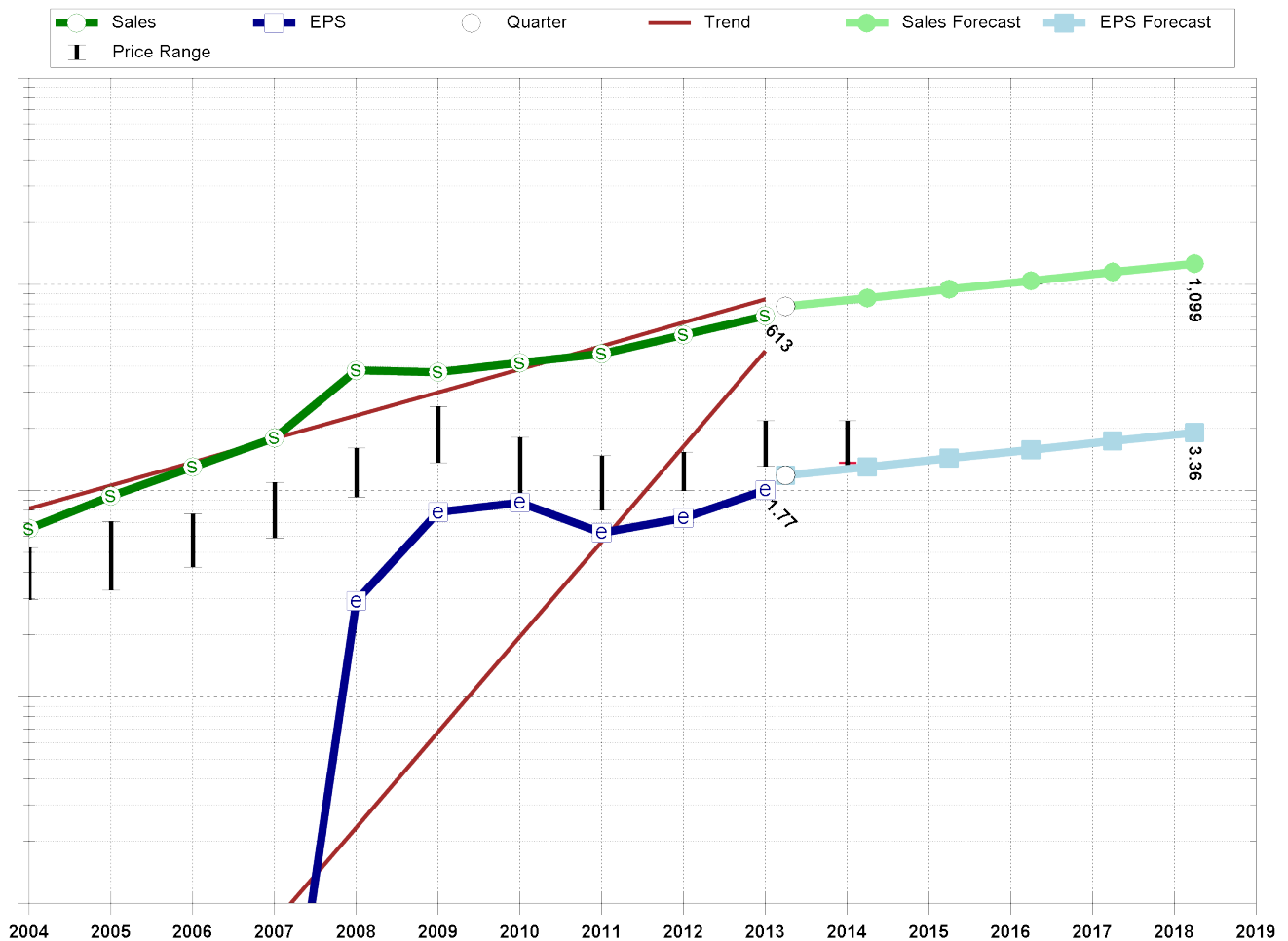

This shows how stock prices have fluctuated with earnings and dividends. It is building block for translating earnings into future stock prices.

## 4 EVALUATING RISK and REWARD over the next 5 years

Assuming one recession and one business boom every 5 years, calculations are made of how high and how low the stock might sell. The upside-downside ratio is the key to evaluating risk and reward.

### A HIGH PRICE - NEXT 5 YEARS

Avg. High P/E 16.00 X Estimate High Earnings/Share 3.36 = Forecasted High Price \$ 53.8

### B LOW PRICE - NEXT 5 YEARS

(a) Avg. Low P/E 13.30 X Estimate Low Earnings/Share 2.09 = Forecasted Low Price \$ 27.8

(b) Avg. Low Price of Last 5 Years 18.7

(c) Recent Market Low Price 17.51

(d) Price Dividend Will Support  $\frac{\text{Present Dividend}}{\text{High Yield}} = \frac{0.000}{0.00\%} = 0.0$

Selected Forecasted Low Price 17.5

### C ZONING using 25%-50%-25%

Forecasted High Price 53.8 Minus Forecasted Low Price 17.5 = 36.3 Range. 25% of Range 9.1

Buy Zone 17.5 to 26.6

Hold Zone 26.6 to 44.7

Sell Zone 44.7 to 53.8

Present Market Price of 23.93 is in the **Buy** Zone

### D UPSIDE DOWNSIDE RATIO (POTENTIAL GAIN VS. RISK OR LOSS)

$\frac{\text{High Price} - \text{Present Price}}{\text{Present Price} - \text{Low Price}} = \frac{53.8 - 23.93}{23.93 - 17.5} = \frac{29.83}{6.43} = 4.6$  To 1

### E PRICE TARGET (Note: This shows the potential market price appreciation over the next five years in simple interest terms.)

$\frac{\text{High Price}}{\text{Present Market Price}} = \frac{53.8}{23.93} = 2.25$  X 100 = 224.66 - 100 = 124.7 % Appreciation

## 5 5-YEAR POTENTIAL

This combines price appreciation with dividend yield to get an estimate of total return. It provides a standard for comparing income and growth stocks.

A  $\frac{\text{Present Full Year's Dividend \$}}{\text{Present Price of Stock}} = \frac{0.00}{23.93} = 0.00 = 0.0\%$  Present Yield

### B AVERAGE YIELD - USING FORECAST HIGH P/E

$\frac{\text{Avg. \% Payout}}{\text{Forecast High PE}} = \frac{0.0\%}{16.00} = 0.0\%$

### AVERAGE YIELD - USING FORECAST AVERAGE P/E

$\frac{\text{Avg. \% Payout}}{\text{Forecast Average PE}} = \frac{0.0\%}{14.65} = 0.0\%$
